The 4 persons undersigned, all members of the Mohawk Council of Elders & Working Committee of Kanesatake, and also representing the Kanesatake Chamber of Commerce and the Tea8eakenrat Community of Kanesatake-Oka have unanimously agreed to organized and operate a Selection Committee for Housing in Kanesatake for the attribution of the proprerties that will be acquired by the Federal Government in the fourth enclaves south of Highway 344 in Kanesatake.

The following organisations will be invited to delegate members to form the Selection Committee:

- 2 members from: Mohawk Council of Elders & Working Committee of Kanesatake
- 2 " " Chamber of Commerce of Kanesatake
- 2 " " Tea8eakenrat Community of Kanesatake-Oka
- 2 " " Elected Chiefs of Mohawk Council of Kanesatake
- 2 " " Long House
- 1 Adviser

A minimum of 3 Elders is required among the 11 members of the Selection Committee.

The Committee will prepare the by-law and regulations to be presented for acceptation by public workshops of members of the Mohawk Community before final approval submitted to Minister of Indian Affairs.


