Dear Mr. Ouelette,

We acknowledge receipt of your resolution numbered 85-142. We would like to remind you of the contents of our resolution dated October 22, 1985, where we quoted article three (3) of the Proclamation Act of 1763 and which is reaffirmed by the Canadian Constitution Act of 1982. In addition to the previous mentioned Acts (documents), we have more documented support that Kanesatake (Oka) is **MOHAWK INDIAN LAND**.

Be advised that installing signs on **OUR ABORIGINAL LAND** is just a small step as to what our future goal is. We also forbid any persons whomsoever to take our signs down.

Furthermore, a municipality can **NEVER OWN LAND, IT IS ONLY THE INDIAN PEOPLE WHO OWN THE LAND OF THIS COUNTRY.**

Once again, we invite you and your council to meet with us as soon as possible to come to an understanding about our land.
